Notice Regarding Completion of Amagasaki Comprehensive Pressure Test Station

Taiyo Nippon Sanso Corporation (“TNSC”, President: Kenji Nagata) hereby announces the building has been completed and the equipment has been installed for the comprehensive pressure test station for reinspecting high pressure cylinders, which it started newly constructing at the Amagasaki Facility in spring 2021.

1. Background

In the Group’s business area centered around Osaka City, TNSC’s group companies have the various functions required for and have engaged in cylinder gas business separately. In addition, they have performed cylinder reinspection※ essential for those operations at test stations within and outside of the Group.

Given this situation and medium- to long-term demand trends for cylinder gas, TNSC newly established the comprehensive pressure test station as part of initiatives to shore up the foundation for maintaining and enhancing the Group’s overall earnings. Group companies will work together at the comprehensive pressure test station to leverage economies of scale to raise productivity, make distribution more efficient, take measures to address aging equipment and avoid overlapping investments, realize steady succession of technology within the Group, and establish a sustainable business foundation.

(※)Pressure tests are performed periodically on high pressure gas cylinders as required by the High Pressure Gas Safety Act.

2. Overview of Comprehensive Pressure Test Station

Location:	1-95 Motohamacho, Amagasaki, Hyogo (on the premise of TNSC’s Amagasaki Facility)
Building area:	1,464.76 m ²
Business description:	Periodic testing and maintenance of general seamless cylinders, general composite vessels, cryogenic vessels, and fittings
Equipment overview:	4 non-water-tank type automatic pressure testing systems , 2 valve testing machines, 3 shotblasting machines, 3 powder coating systems, 2 automatic marking machines, etc.
Cylinders handled:	Oxygen, nitrogen, argon, helium, hydrogen, carbon dioxide, and other cylinders
Start of operations:	July 2022
